The Australian War Memorial's Anzac Centenary Print Portfolio brings together works by ten prominent artists from Australia and New Zealand and their British counterparts to what is considered a conflict that took place a century ago. The artist edition portfolio comprising of linocuts, etchings, woodcut and screen prints was created by David Boyd, Megan Upton, John Johnson, Wynne Hill and Benjamin Franklin from Australia and Bruce Gifford, David Johnston, Peter Jack, John Gifford and William Spring from New Zealand. It is one of the most significant art commissions projects ever undertaken by the Australian War Memorial to commemorate the legacy of the Anzac experience. Each print was produced at the renowned Wynne Hill Studio in Canberra under the guidance of Master Printmaker Johnstone. The exhibition in New Delhi is the largest of one of the 20 portfolios.
