
Sealed tender are invited by the Director General, NGMA, New Delhi, for disposal of various condemned/ unserviceable Iron panel/board, iron pieces wooden tables/chairs, wooden and plywood pieces; porta cabin etc. on "as is where is" basis.

The goods/materials can be inspected by the prospective tenderers or their authorized representatives in the premises of the Gallery during the office hours from 01/8/2022 to 03/8/2022

Tender will be opened at 14.00 Hrs. On 04.08.2022 in the presences of such of the tenders or theirs authorized representatives who may wish to attend.

**General Condition:**

1. Sealed tenders superscripted "Tender for Unserviceable Items addressed to the Director General, National Gallery of Modern Art, Jaipur House, Near India Gate, New Delhi so as to reach him on before 04.08.2022 at 12.30 pm.
2. A sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) is required to be deposited as Earnest Money along with the tenders in the form of Grossed bankers Cheque/ Pay order/ bank Draft
3. Material should be removed on; as is whereas; basis within 03 days from the receipt of acceptance order after depositing the full amount (after adjusting Earnest Money of Rs.5, 000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) with the cashier of the Gallery in the form of Crossed Bank Draft/ Pay Order/ Banker Cheque drawn in favor of the Drawing and Disbursing Officer, National Gallery of Modern Art, New Delhi. In case material is not removed within the prescribed time the Earnest Money will be forfeited and any loss whatsoever occurring due to this will be recovered from the bidder.
4. The inspection of material should be done carefully and queries based to the concern officers at time of inspection no further clarifications shall be given after the above inspection.
5. No damage should be caused to the existing property of the Gallery of Government while removing the auctioned articles from the site. Any law/damage to the Government/Gallery of injury or personal accident suffered by any person due to the negligence or the action of the successful bidder or his authorised worker/ Supervisor will have to indemnified by the successful contractor.
6. Goods/Martial to be removed will be under the supervisor of designated officer of the Gallery.
7. Goods/Martial will be allowed to be removed only during working hours. The articles will not be allowed to be removed on holidays or after working hours.
8. Bidders should indicate in the question. Their permanent income Tax No./GST no/Tin no. also furnish the copy of last 2 years income tax return.
