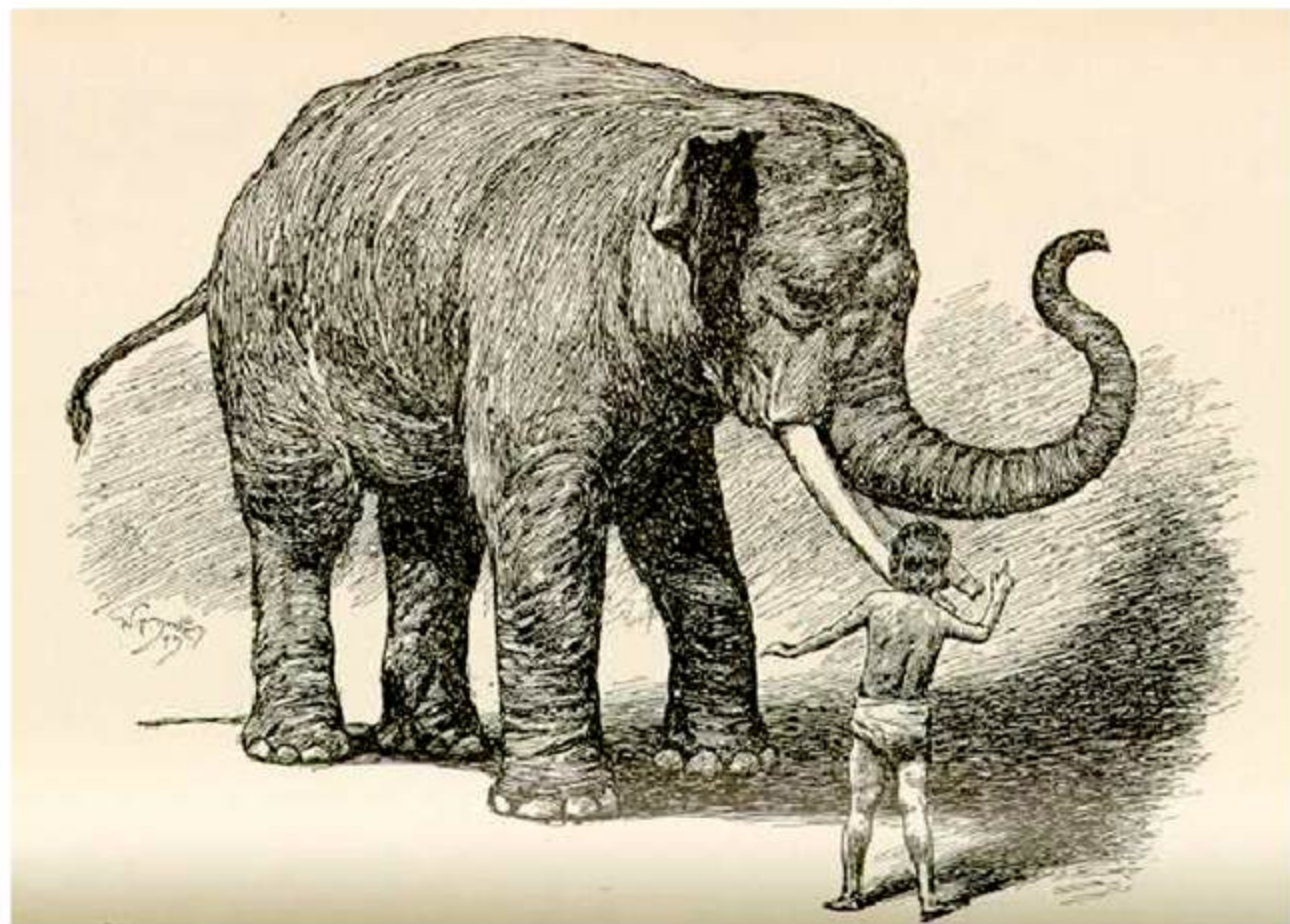

Elephant Boy the charming translation of Rudyard Kipling's *Jungle Book* story "Toomai of the Elephants" won best director honours at the Venice Film Festival in the late '30s.

The film propelled the young thirteen year old Sabu, a mahout's son from Mysore into the world of Hollywood movies. Shot in Mysore in the 30s the film is a blend of the two film makers' styles- Flaherty's flair for ethnographic documentary combined with Korda's taste for adventure and, has some incredible glimpses of the old Khedda operation.
